Walking in the Holy Spirit

Day One — Read <u>Galatians 5:16-25, Romans 8:12-17,</u> <u>1 Corinthians 2:9-12</u>

What is the driving 'force' that motivates your decisions and actions? Do you sense the Spirit's leading in your everyday activities? Have you been filled with the Spirit?

Pray and ask God to fill you with the Holy Spirit. Ask Him to reveal the promptings of the Spirit throughout your day and for wisdom on how to apply His word to your life.

Day Two — Read Romans 8:1-4, 2 Corinthians 3:7-18, Galatians 5:1, Romans 6:18-22

Are there areas of bondage in your life? A sin that seems impossible to overcome? A relationship that needs healing? How can the Spirit help You in these areas? Are there people in your life to help you walk in freedom?

Pray and ask God for freedom! Claim and believe the promises in Scripture for YOURSELF today!

Day Three — Read Ephesians 1:15-23, 2 Timothy 1:7, 1 Corinthians 4:20, Romans 15:13, Ephesians 3:14-21

What does the power of the Spirit look like in your everyday life? In your family? At work? Do you sense the power of the Spirit? What is one thing right now that you need His power for? Challenge yourself to memorize one verse about the Spirit's power for times of need.

Pray and ask God for power to live victoriously in Him today. Thank the Father for providing everything you need for living a fruitful life in Christ.
