Living with Dual Citizenship

Day One – Read Proverbs 3:5-6; Matthew 22:37-40.

As a nation, we are so grateful for our freedom! We remember and celebrate our hard fought independence. But we are all "dependent" on certain things/people as well. As people created in the image of God for relationship, we are dependent upon God and other people. When does healthy dependence become unhealthy "codependence?"

Pray and ask God to help you develop greater dependence on him, and healthier dependence on other people.

<u>Day Two</u> – Read <u>Romans 12:1-2; Colossians 3:17;</u> Ephesians 5:25.

How do healthier marriages and families, and stronger churches, help make for a stronger and healthier nation? How could confusion about the *"three realms of responsibility"* work to minimize our effectiveness?

Pray – Ask God to help you actively commit to working for a healthier family and a stronger local church.

Day Three – Read 1 Timothy 2:1-2; 2 Chronicles 7:14.

As we enter another presidential election season, let's commit ourselves to do it better! Let's pray more, bash people less, become more informed (reading more party platforms and objective voter guides and watching less cable news!) Let's get more prayerful and informed, and less angry and cynical.

Pray - Ask God to give us grace and wisdom. Pray for national civility and unity in the face of division and hatred. Ask that God will have mercy on our nation and give us a true, national, spiritual awakening! As 2 Chronicles 7:14 says, it up to us, as God's people, to humble ourselves and pray! We must seek God's face and turn from our wicked ways! It's much easier to blame others than take responsibility ourselves! Let's commit ourselves to praye!

1. Commit <u>Ourselves to God</u>
