## **Developing True Community**

Day One – John 13:34, John 17:23 & Philippians 1:9-11. When Jesus gave the command to really "love each other" as he loves us, and prayed that we would be brought together in "complete unity," what does that kind of community look like in today's world? In our church? In your family? What are the words and phrases in Philippians 1:9-11 that describe this kind of authentic community?

**Pray** - Thank God for the relationships in your life. Pray that together you will make a mutual commitment to develop authentic community.

<u>Day Two</u> – <u>Read Romans</u> 12:9, <u>Proverbs</u> 15:28; <u>Ephesians</u> 4:15 & 29 & <u>John</u> 1:14. How do our words help or hurt the development of authentic community? Why do we need both "grace and truth" in a healthy relationship? How do you know what to say, how to say it, and when or when not to say it?

**Pray** – Thank God for his Word, and that it has come to us in Christ, the Word of God – made flesh. Pray that his Word would "dwell in us richly" so that our words would be helpful as we encourage each other with the truth. Ask God to help you speak helpful, hopeful and healing words today. And, if difficult truth needs to be shared, ask that you will speak it in love.

**Day Three** – **Ephesians 2:8-10; Galatians 6:10; Romans 12:9-21**. We are not saved "by good works," but we are saved "for good works." To be "holy" is to be cleansed and set apart for a purpose. God has a purpose for us individually and collectively. The best "good work" we can do is to "love one another." (John 13:34; 17:23) May our service to each other and with each other be like a light in this dark world. May we shine for the glory of God! (Matthew 5:16; Philippians 2:15.)

**Pray** - Ask God that together, as a church, we can do all he's calling us to do. Who are the people you are serving? Who's serving you? Who are you serving with?

True Riches #7

<u>1 John 1:7</u> (NIV) <sup>7</sup> If we **walk in the light**, as he is in the light, we have **fellowship** with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin. 2 Corinthians 6:14

# **Building Blocks of True Community**

## 1. The Courage to Seek Christ

<u>Luke 9:23</u> (NLT) <sup>23</sup> Then Jesus said to the crowd, "If any of you wants to be my follower, you must turn from your selfish ways, take up your cross daily, and follow me. John 10:10b; 13:34; 1 Corinthians 12:12, 14

Ephesians 4:3-6 (NIV) <sup>3</sup> Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace. <sup>4</sup> There is one body and one Spirit-- just as you were called to one hope when you were called-- <sup>5</sup> one Lord, one faith, one baptism; <sup>6</sup> one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.

#### 2. The Commitment to Grow .

Philippians 1:9-10 (NLT) <sup>9</sup> I pray that your love will overflow more and more, and that you will keep on growing in knowledge and understanding. <sup>10</sup> For I want you to understand what really matters, so that you may live pure and blameless lives until the day of Christ's return.

Romans 12:10 (NIV) Be devoted to one another in brotherly love. Honor one another above yourselves. honor (time - "to treat with value; to appreciate")

Romans 12:11–12 (NIV) Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord. <sup>12</sup> Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer. James 5:16

# 3. The <u>Willingness</u> to <u>Be Real</u>.

**Romans 12:9** (NIV) Love must be **sincere**. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good. John 1:14; Proverbs 15:28; 27:6, 17

**Ephesians 4:15, 29** (NIV) **Speaking the truth in love,** we will **in all things grow up** into him who is the Head, that is, Christ. Do not let any **unwholesome talk** come out of your mouths, but **only** what is **helpful** for **building others up** according to **their needs**, that it may **benefit** those who **listen**. Proverbs 25:11; 2 Timothy 4:2; 1 Thessalonians 5:14

## 4. The <u>Resolve</u> to <u>Stay</u>.

John 17:23 (NIV) May they be brought to complete unity to let the world know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me.

Romans 12:16 (NIV) Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position. Do not be conceited.

(The Message) **Get along** with each other; don't be **stuck-up**. Make friends with **nobodies**; don't be **the great somebody**. Romans 12:3-5; Philippians 2:3-7

Romans 12:17–18 (NIV) Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everybody. <sup>18</sup> If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.

#### 5. The Readiness to Serve .

Ephesians 2:8-10 (NLT) <sup>8</sup> God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God. <sup>9</sup> Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it. <sup>10</sup> For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago. <sup>2</sup> Corinthians 1:3-4

Romans 12:13 (NIV) Share with God's people who are in need. Practice hospitality.

<u>Galatians 6:10 (NIV)</u> Therefore, as we have **opportunity**, let us **do good to all people**, especially to those who belong to **the family of believers**. Proverbs 11:25; Acts 2:45

Romans 12:15 (NIV) Rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who mourn.

Job's Friends, Job 2:11 – 13 Hushai, David's Friend, 1 Chronicles 27:33; 2 Sam. 15:32

Proverbs 10:19b, 32a 19a He who holds his tongue is wise. 32a the lips of the righteous know what is fitting. Proverbs 27:6
