Ownership: Relinquish ownership

Matthew 25:14 “The Kingdom of Heaven can be illustrated by the story of a man going on a long trip. He called together his servants and entrusted his money to them while he was gone.

Responsibility: Assume responsibility

Matthew 25:16 The man who had received the five talents went at once and put his money to work and gained five more.

Accountability: Anticipate accountability

Matthew 25:19 “After a long time their master returned from his trip and called them to give an account of how they had used his money

Reward: Welcome reward

Matthew 25:21 “His master replied, ‘Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master’s happiness!’

Becoming Responsible Stewards

Step 1. Focus

"The successful man is the average man, focused." —Unknown

Matthew 25:14 He called together his servants and entrusted his money to them while he was gone.

Step 2. Begin

Step 3. Practice
