What is Our Responsibility in Politics?

1. Affirm the <u>Purpose</u> of Good Government.

Romans 13:1-2, 4 "Everyone must submit himself to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except that which God has established. The authorities that exist have been established by God. Consequently, he who rebels against the authority is rebelling against what God has institutes, and those who do so will bring judgment on themselves. Rulers are God's servants to do you good."

<u>1 Peter 2:13-15</u> "Submit yourselves for the Lord's sake to every authority instituted among men: whether to the king, as the supreme authority, or to governors, who are sent by him to punish those who do wrong and to commend those who do right. For it is God's will that by doing good you should silence the ignorant talk of foolish men."

2. Accept the <u>Position</u> We Hold as Citizens.

Matthew 22:21(NIV) "Give to Caesar what is Caesar's, and to God what is God's."
