A Prayer for Wisdom

Ephesians 3:14-19 (NIV) ¹⁴ For this reason I kneel before the Father, ¹⁵ from whom his whole family in heaven and on earth derives its name. ¹⁶ I pray **that** out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, ¹⁷ so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray **that** you, being rooted and established in love, ¹⁸ may have power, together with all the saints, <u>to grasp</u> how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, ¹⁹ and <u>to know</u> this love that surpasses knowledge—**that** you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.

Through the church

Ephesians 3:10 (NIV) ¹⁰ His intent was that now, through the church, the manifold wisdom of God should be made known...

Ephesians 3:6 (NIV) ⁶ This mystery is that through the gospel the <u>Gentiles</u> are heirs <u>together with Israel</u>, members <u>together of one body</u>, and sharers <u>together in the promise</u> in Christ Jesus.

Ephesians 3:10 (NIV) ¹⁰ His intent was that now, through the church, the manifold wisdom of God should be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly realms...

- ... who has blessed us in the <u>heavenly realms</u> (1:3)
- ... seated us with him in the <u>heavenly realms</u> (2:6)

Angelic observers:

<u>1Peter 1:10-12</u> (NIV) ¹⁰ Concerning this salvation, the prophets... searched intently and with the greatest care, ¹¹ trying to find out the time and circumstances to which the Spirit of Christ in them was pointing when he predicted the sufferings of Christ and the glories that would follow. ¹² ... Even angels long to look into these things.

1Corinthians 4:9 (NIV) ⁹ For it seems to me that God has put us apostles on display at the end of the procession, like men condemned to die in the arena. We have been made a spectacle [θέατρον, theatron] to the whole universe, to angels as well as to men.
